- **Spring Session 2010**– 1/4/2010-5/22/2010 – 19 weeks

Spring Break – no classes the week of March 29-April 3, 2010

REGISTRATION FOR SPRING 2010 WILL BE THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 14-19, 2009. ONE-HALF OF THE SPRING 2010 PAYMENT IS DUE BY DECEMBER 19, 2009.

► **Costume Money is due when registering for the Spring 2010 session (See attached).**

THE SECOND ONE-HALF OF THE SPRING 2010 PAYMENT IS DUE BY MARCH 6, 2010.

Recital Information

The studio's annual recital is Saturday, May 22, 2010 at 3:00pm at the Woodstock Opera House. Dress rehearsal (at the Woodstock Opera House) is Friday, May 21, 2010 from 6-10pm. Every student **must** attend this dress rehearsal.

In order to be in the recital, all students must be registered by January 30, 2010 (with costume money paid for).

- **Summer Session I** – 6/7/2010-7/10/2010 – 5 weeks
(No class Saturday, July 3, 2010)

Registration Week for Current Students for Summer Session I is the week of May 10-May 17, 2010. Registration is due for the entire 5 week session.

- **Summer Session II** – 7/19/2010-8/21/2010 – 5 weeks

Registration Week for Current Students for Summer Session II is the week of June 28-July 3, 2010. Registration is due for the entire 5 week session.

- **Fall Session 2010** – Monday- 8/30/2010-12/19/2010 – 16 weeks
(No class Monday, September 6, 2010 for Labor Day and
No Class Thursday, November 25, 2010 for Thanksgiving)

Registration Week for Current Students for Fall Session 2010 is the week of August 16-August 21, 2010. One Half of the Fall Session 2009 Payment is Due by August 21, 2010. The second one-half payment for the Fall Session 2009 is due by October 23, 2010.

For classes falling on Monday, September 6, 2010 and Thursday, November 25, 2010, students can make up that class with another class (per instructors permission). These classes will not count as part of the two makeup classes/session.

Registration is always open, but class size is limited
